If colleges require a health care provider signature to verify, you must take it to your physician, not the Shorecrest health office. Tetanus boosters are required every 10 years; it may be time to update. If you are going to college and especially if you are going to live in a dorm next year, talk to your doctor about the meningitis immunization. SC nurses strongly recommend all students get the Hepatitis B series of immunizations even if you are not going to college.
