**AP TESTING** begins Monday May 4 at the Shoreline Center. Students who think they may want to test, even if they are not sure, should register by the March 27 deadline to avoid hefty late fees. Test fees are \$86 each, by check to Shorecrest. Pre-administration answer sheets will be completed April 13 & 14. Mrs. Gastaldi has details, and information on fee reduction applications, in the counseling center. AP exam scores may qualify a student for college credit.
