## LEGISLATION - PTA voices raised for Education Issues:

Three SC delegates attended the 2009 Legislative Assembly where two issues were added for PTA support: funding of Highly-Capable programs, and support for Music and Arts Education. These are added to the current 2-year platform for focus in lobbying legislators in Olympia. PTA FOCUS DAY in Olympia is January 18, 2010.

**NO on I-1033:** The State PTA Board followed the Shoreline PTA Council and voted to oppose the passage of I-1033. The **SC PTSA voted unanimously to oppose I-1033**, which if passed, would impose caps on state spending that would deepen and extend the crisis in funding education and healthcare in our state.
