- * **Report cards** will be handed out on Feb. 9.
- * Students will receive materials for **next year's registration** in Feb.
- * **Traffic Safety Education**, March 26 - June 4, no class during Spring break. Registration begins Feb. 5 in Counseling Office.
- * An informational meeting for students interested in running for ASB and senator positions will be held on Feb. 8 at TAP in the Theater.
- * Pick up **spring sports packets** for track, baseball, softball, golf, boys soccer or girls tennis **NOW**. Spring sports begin Feb. 26. Packets due Feb. 16. Only one physical exam required per year. Download the sports physical form from the Shorecrest website.
- * The following **Athletic Eligibility Rules** are in effect at Shorecrest: **BEFORE the athlete may begin practicing:** All athletic participation forms must be turned in, including the Athletic Participation Permission Form, the yellow emergency card, and a current physical clearing the athlete for participation must be on file. **BEFORE the athlete may participate in competition,** the athlete must be enrolled in at least 4 classes and be passing each. Failing grades from prior grading periods may affect eligibility. The athlete must complete the minimum number of practices: football and wrestling - 12, gymnastics - 15, all other sports - 10. An ASB card must be purchased. The district athletic participation fee must be paid, and any uniforms/equipment from prior sports season must be returned or fine paid. Safety Guidelines form must be turned in.
