- * **Last chance to claim missing possessions** from the Counseling Office Lost & Found! Items will be donated to charity June 29.
- * **Notice:** All fines and fees are posted weekly in the SAC and need to be paid ASAP. Diplomas and annuals will not be given out until the last day of school if fees or fines are not paid. Clear fines during TAP or lunch with: **Library** – Mrs. Jordan, library; **Books/Class fees** – Mrs. Monahan, counseling; **Music and ASB/Athletics** – Mrs. Velie, main office.
- * **Credit restoration application**, for those with 9 or more absences, are available in Attendance Office. You have to be passing the class and have no more than one unexcused absence. Return by June 8 (seniors) and June 21 (grades 9-11).
- * **Shoreline Summer School** will be June 28 - Aug. 26. Students must attend an orientation on June 28 at the Shorewood Library to participate. Classes are being offered online and cost \$100.00 per class. Please see your counselor for registration paperwork and to gain approval for the appropriate course(s). Once you have your paperwork approved, all payments are made directly at the Shoreline School District Accounting office. If you have further questions and for more information, check out the district website.
- * The Shorecrest main office will be open during regular school hours through June and will reopen Aug. 13.
- * **Final report cards** will be mailed home in early July.
- * **Fall sports** begin August 20. Football begins Aug. 15 for upperclassmen. Packets may be turned in at school the week of Aug. 6.
- * **Fall schedules** and other important information will be mailed home in August.
- * **DDD Summer Conditioning Camp** will be held at SC from July 2 - Aug 17, 8:00- 9:30 AM, Mon. – Fri. Cost: \$50. It's open to all Shoreline students entering grades 8 - 12. Pick up registration forms by Mrs. Velie's window.
- * The **2007 August High School WASL** will be given Aug. 6-9. All tests will be given at Shoreline Center. Each subject will have both a morning and an afternoon test; both must be taken for a student to be eligible to pass the subject test. Students currently in grades 10, 11, or 12 will be able to register from June 8 to July 8 to take the August WASL. August testing is not available to current 9th graders. Families should receive results from the spring tests around mid-June. Students will be able to register online at www.k12.wa.us/wasl registration or by phone at 1.866.400.9275 during the registration period. Students will need to have their SSID number when they register. A letter will be sent home in June with information.
