## THROUGH MRS. VELIE'S WINDOW (Athletics & ASB)

\***ASB cards** may be purchased for \$30 in the main office during TAP or lunch. These picture ID cards entitle students to free admission at Shorecrest home sporting events, including Shoreline Stadium. All students who participate in ASB funded activities (sports, clubs, music, drama, etc.) are required to buy an ASB card. ASB cards will not be ready until after picture day. **Keep your ASB card receipt** and show it and a picture ID for entrance to Shorecrest events.

\***Loch 2008**, the Shorecrest annual, may be ordered for \$55 with ASB card, \$60 without. Buy early - price increases to \$60 / \$65 after Jan. 1.

## NOTES FROM ADMINISTRATION

\***Family Access** is a website tied in to the computer system that is used to record student attendance, grades, schedules, etc. Packets have been mailed to each student's family that contain updated Family Access information for this year. Please read the lavender flyer, log in to the website, and enjoy the ease of keeping up to date with your student's records. Click on "Account Info" to change your password, and check or enter your e-mail address. By providing your e-mail address, school administration will be able to reach you by e-mail with important information. You are encouraged to become familiar with Family Access and use it often.

\***Annual update forms** have also been mailed to families. Please read, check accuracy of the information, and return these forms to the Shorecrest office.

## FOR YOUR INFORMATION

\***Parking permit applications** are available now (for juniors with junior credit status and seniors only) in the Activity Office. Cost is \$25 with ASB card, \$30 without. All fines and fees must be cleared before purchasing a pass.

\***Students purchasing school pictures** need to bring order forms (sent home first week of school) to their English teachers on Sept. 20 or 21. All students will be photographed for ID purposes. No hats allowed for ID purposes, but OK for purchased pictures.

\***The deadline for Senior Annual Photos is Mon, Oct. 5.** Specs: background color – indigo; photo size – 2" x 3"; head size – 1¼" (top of head to bottom of chin). Free photos with the senior background will be available on picture days, Sept. 20-21.

\***Students who require medication** during school hours must have a physician's request for medication administration form on file in the Shorecrest Health Office.
