COLLEGE OUTLOOK AND CAREER CENTER

- * Check the Career Center Website for a log of any scholarships that have come through the Center. They are updated frequently. The Career center will be open the following days after school from 2:30-4:00 PM for any seniors needing a quiet space and a little support to complete College applications: **Dec. 5, 6, 12, 13, and 19.**
- * Attention parents of college bound **juniors**. Shorecrest High School will contract with Seattle Test Prep to conduct an SAT Prep Class at Shorecrest Saturday mornings Jan. 12 – Feb. 23. This is good timing to prepare for the March 1 SAT Test. The cost is \$250. You will receive a brochure in the mail providing more details and sign up information.
- * Would you like some advice and real life experience from an alumnus of a college you are applying to? Look at the map outside the Career Center to see where the Shorecrest Staff went to College. They are all proud alumni and would be glad to talk to you.
- * Students who need help or have questions regarding **college applications and financial aid forms** can make an appointment with the Career Center. If you need a **counselor recommendation or school report forms**, notify the Counseling Office at least three weeks (excluding vacation and weekends) prior to your deadline.
- * **Beware of Scholarship Scams!** Scholarship scams target families all year long. In general: Don't spend money on a scholarship "matching" service or to get "help" filling out financial aid forms -- free help is always available. Statements about funds going unclaimed are simply untrue. No one can guarantee that you will win a scholarship. No legitimate scholarship would require your credit card number or bank account numbers. No one else can fill out scholarship applications for a student. No reputable service would pressure you to give them a check or credit card number without giving you enough time to think it over.
