- * **Claim any missing possessions** from the Counseling Office Lost & Found! Items will be donated to charity after June 10.
- * **Notice:** All fines and fees are posted weekly in the SAC should have been paid by May 30. Diplomas and annuals will not be given out until the last day of school if fees or fines are not paid. Clear fines during TAP or lunch with: **Library** – Mrs. Jordan, library; **Books/Class fees** – Mrs. Monahan, counseling; **Music and ASB/Athletics** – Mrs. Velie, main office.
- * **Second semester credit restoration applications** are available in the Attendance Office, for students who have accumulated 9 or more absences in one or more classes. You have to be passing the class and have no more than one unexcused absence. Return applications by June 6 (seniors) and June 13 (grades 9-11).
- * **Shoreline Summer School** will be July 7 - Aug. 1 Registration is open; visit the district website for specific information on classes and how to register; <http://learn.shorelineschools.org/spec/sschool/index.php>.
- * The Shorecrest main office will be open during regular school hours through June and will reopen Aug. 15.
- * **Final report cards** will be mailed home by the end of June.
- * Fall sports begin August 25. Football begins Aug. 20 for upperclassmen. Packets may be turned in at school the week of Aug. 18.
- * **Fall schedules** and other important information will be mailed home in August. Returning students will have a small window in the summer for schedule adjustments: Seniors (by credits) on Wednesday, August 20 in the morning; Juniors on up (by credits) on Thursday, August 21 in the morning; and Sophomores on up (by credits) on Friday, August 22 in the morning.
- * **DDD Summer Conditioning Camp** will be held at SC from June 23 - Aug 8, 8:00- 9:30 AM, Mon. – Fri. Cost: \$60. It's open to all Shoreline students entering grades 8 - 12. Pick up registration forms by Mrs. Velie's window.
- * The **2007 August High School WASL** will be given Aug. 11-14. Students currently in grades 10, 11, or 12 may register from June 9 -27. Students will be able to register and view testing locations online at www.k12.wa.us/waslregistration. Results from this year's WASL will reach homes before the end of school in June, which will assist in determining the need for August testing.
