CAREER AND COLLEGE NEWS

AP TESTING begins Monday May 4 at the Shoreline Center. Students who think they may want to test, even if they are not sure, should register by the March 27 deadline to avoid late fees. Tests are \$86 each, by check to Shorecrest. Pre-administration answer sheets will be completed April 13 &14. Mrs. Gastaldi has details, and information on fee reduction applications, in the counseling center. AP exam scores may gualify a student for college credit.

SENIORS – Seniors who are not taking Senior Consumer Economics need to come to the career center to get the state graduation requirement assignment to complete a career portfolio and High School and Beyond Plan.

Continue to check the Scholarship list in the Career Center and on the website. Scholarship opportunities start to drop off in April. **JUNIORS.** Now is the time to sign up for your SAT or ACT test dates, to increase chances of getting into a local testing site.
