## Where Some of the Money Goes:

**Writers In The Schools - WITS** – Seattle Arts and Lectures (SAL) offers year-long author workshops in schools, and this will be Shorecrest's first year with this 25-year-old Seattle program. All regular freshman English classes will participate, and more students can be included if PTSA raises \$3000 above what has been allocated. The program costs nearly \$20,000 but SAL writes grants to cover approx. \$14,000 of this. English teacher Andy Barker is liaison for this program.

- **Saturday, Oct. 17** Shorecrest will offer both the **PSAT**, for juniors, and the **PLAN**, for sophomores, 8 – 11 am. PLAN is a practice ACT. Colleges accept the SAT or the ACT and this is a great way for sophomores to experience a college entrance exam. After taking the PSAT as juniors they will be able to choose which test to take for college entrance. \$19 for the PSAT and \$15 for the PLAN are payable to Mrs. Velie starting Sept. 28.
- **October is Senior Blitz month** in the counseling office, where every senior should make an appointment to talk about post high school plans, the 2 year and 4 year college process and ask any questions.
