Writers In The Schools - WITS – Seattle Arts and Lectures (SAL) offers year-long author workshops in schools, and this will be Shorecrest's first year with this 25-year-old Seattle program. All regular freshman English classes will participate, and more students can be included if PTSA raises \$3000 above what it's allocated. The program costs \$20,000 but SAL writes grants to cover about \$14,000 of this. English teacher Andy Barker is liaison for this program.

SHORELINE FOUNDATION – Say YES! - Last year the Foundation gave **\$21,621 to Shorecrest**; of that, PTSA wrote and received Foundation (and Arts Council -in their joint application) grant monies of approx 6K, which partially funded Shakespeare Day; an ELL art and culture project, *Altars From Around the World*; and help with Wednesday Math nights.
