- ❖ **FACTS: Three proposals**, (1) replacing an expiring levy; (2) a bond for the modernization/replacement of the 2 high schools; (3) a 4-year capital levy for technology support. If all three proposals are approved, the estimated new combined levy and bond rate in 2011 and 2012 would be \$5.25 per \$1,000 of assessed value, and a stable \$5.15 in the years following. Current 2010 rates are \$5.29 per \$1,000, representing no change to the average taxpayer.
